At the annual meeting, congregational members voted to balance the 2018 budget using the Estate gift.

I had an eventful Sunday morning on February 17th of this year. I was invited to pulpit supply in the Finley Lutheran Parish, a three-point parish in rural Northeast North Dakota. I made my way to the first worship service about six miles outside of Finley at Sheyenne Valley Lutheran Church and had no problems finding the lovely little country church. We enjoyed worship, fellowship and conversation and then I started out toward the town church in Finley. I followed the "reliable" GPS system in my car on the road that seemed to be the most direct. Unfortunately, GPS doesn't consider North Dakota "Minimum Maintenance Roads" or recent weather events! Though the directions were clear and simple, the road conditions were unpredictable, and I ended up stuck in a nice snowdrift. Thanks to wonderful new friends and helpers, I was quickly "rescued" and placed upon a cleared, safe road. I thought that I knew the way. I thought that it would be a quick, uneventful drive from point A to point B. But I encountered changing conditions that surprised me and challenged me to see my journey in a different light.

Lent is often referred to as a time of pilgrimage, a journey of trust toward the cross with Jesus. We walk through the passion story of Jesus, spotting the same old signposts along the way: the triumphal entry into Jerusalem, the cleansing of the Temple, the last supper, praying in the garden, Judas' betrayal and Jesus' arrest, the trial of the Sanhedrin, Peter's denial, the trial of Pontius Pilate, the road to Golgotha, the crucifixion, the death, the burial of Jesus. It's easy to think that we already know the road well, and this map-out of God's love for us in Jesus might feel a bit humdrum. One elderly member of the congregation I grew up in once noted in a conversation around Easter that "every year it's the same: Jesus is born, then he dies, then he is raised up to new life again."

But the truth is that we hear this story afresh in our ears each year; the road conditions are different each time we approach this journey to the cross, even though the destination, the crucified and resurrected Christ, remains steadfast. We can trust that Jesus is present with us. We can trust that even though the road conditions might change rapidly, the destination remains pinpointed on the map, and our guide for the journey shows up. We can trust that the One who has trod this way before is the Risen Christ. Thanks be to God!

**Virgil Wander.** MSUM graduate Leif Enger. Fiction. Portrait of residents in a small Minnesota town who together try to revive their once thriving community.

### **Gutenberg to the Internet in the Flash of a Prairie Lifetime.**

Fargo businessman Howard Barlow. Memoir about growing up in South Dakota in the 40's along with his experiences as a newspaper printer in the 50's and 60's.

**Sister Secrets: A Brother's Reveal.** Matt Valan (Messiah Lutheran pastor who formerly served at Olivet) Nonfiction. A family's experiences with mental health issues.

**Murder at Pelican Lake.** Marjorie Mathison (Pelican Lake summer resident). Fiction. A teenager is abducted and Carley, the protagonist, realizes this vacation community might have darker secrets than she ever knew.

**Love without Limits: Jesus' Radical Vision for Love with No Exceptions.** Concordia College theology professor Jacqueline Bussie. Part memoir, part how-to-guide on how to love others. Challenges readers to answer God's call to practice a love so vast it excludes no one.
