She continues her work with the large amount of communications we need, and will also work diligently to help Olivet grow in mission and outreach. Bev has fantastic ideas and we are blessed she is willing to share her passion and talents. On a sad note, Dr. Jeff Meyer is no longer leading the music for our late service. Switching gears to our financial picture. Pledged income was down significantly from expectations through March 31. However, April proved to be a strong financial month. OLIVET FOOD PANTRY UPDATE

There is so much happening in the Olivet Food Pantry. Here are some details to get you caught up:

1. Our April 8th Crooked Pint fundraiser brought in \$255. We are grateful to everyone who sacrificed cooking and washing dishes to join in the fun!
2. April 1st was our second biggest day in the pantry, with a total of 52 families fed. We donated around a ton of food that evening.
3. In March, we fed 56 families (80 children, 95 adults, 27 seniors).
4. The pantry is a busy place, and we constantly seek new ways to keep up with demand. We are looking at more adjustments to our hours of operation as we go into the summer. Stay tuned for more details.
5. Due to an increase in the numbers of guests we serve, efficiency is becoming a priority. One way to accomplish this is by streamlining what we offer to guests. Here is our wish list: pasta, pasta sauce, baked beans, canned meat, soup, canned vegetables and fruits, toilet paper, paper towel, breakfast (Cheerios, Chex, Frosted Flakes), toiletries (shampoo, soap, tooth brush, tooth paste, deodorant), taco fixings, ketchup, mustard, and jelly. We are grateful for the congregation's generosity to keep this ministry running!
